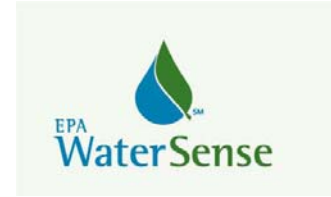

# Program Eligibility & Instructions

- ◆ Rebate only applies to the installation of WaterSense labeled 1.28 gallon per flush toilets.
- ◆ Property **must** have a water account with MWC.
- ◆ Rebate offer applies only to single family residential accounts.
- ◆ Applicant must own the property where toilets are being installed.
- ◆ Maximum of 2 toilet rebates per residence.
- ◆ Program begins November 1, 2009, with rebates issued on a first come first served basis; program may end if funds are depleted.
- ◆ A \$100 rebate (less \$5 voucher) will be issued for the replacement of a toilet flushing 3 gallons per flush or more, or \$50 (less \$5 voucher) for the replacement of a toilet flushing 1.6 gallons. A \$50 rebate will also be given in new construction for the installation of a qualifying 1.28 gallon toilet in lieu of a 1.6 gallon model.
- ◆ Please allow 4-6 weeks for the processing of the rebate check.



## Checklist:

- Select a WaterSense toilet.** Qualifying models often are identified with a WaterSense label at the store. Verify by reviewing the list of qualifying toilets on the EPA website: <http://www.epa.gov/watersense>
- Purchase WaterSense toilet.** Toilet model number(s) must match the numbers on the WaterSense list **exactly**. No mixing and matching of tanks and bowls from the list is allowed as each model has been tested in specific combinations for performance and efficiency.
- Complete and submit the rebate application form with sales receipt attached.** Mail or deliver within one month of toilet purchase. Applications will be processed in the order received. Incomplete applications will be returned to the applicant. MWC will contact you to confirm eligibility and set up an inspection.
- Install new WaterSense toilet and receive an installation inspection.** Installation is the responsibility of the applicant. **DO NOT dispose of old toilets until inspection by MWC.** Also, keep the portion of the new toilet's box / packaging with make and model number. Applicants' signature on this form authorizes MWC to perform an onsite inspection. Call MWC at 774-2435 to schedule the inspection. If desired, we will attempt to coordinate timing with your plumber so we can give them a voucher for recycling the old toilet.
- Recycle toilet.** If you hire a plumber, be sure to inform them that the old toilet must be recycled and work out any details ahead of time. Upon confirmation, a voucher (\$5 value) will be issued to the applicant for recycling the old toilet at the Rogue Disposal transfer station (8001 Table Rock Road, White City). Rogue Disposal will validate the voucher and direct you to the designated recycle container. **Recycling the old toilet is required for receipt of rebate.** All metal and plastic parts **must** be removed from the old toilet before being recycled.
