Program Eligibility & Instructions 2010 /2011

- ◆ Rebate only applies to the installation of WaterSense labeled 1.28 gallon per flush toilets.
- ◆ Property must have a water account with MWC.
- ◆ Rebate offer applies only to single family residential accounts.
- ◆ Applicant must own the property where toilets are being installed.
- ◆ Maximum of 2 toilet rebates per residence.
- ◆ Please allow 4-6 weeks for the processing of the rebate check.
- ◆ Rebates will be issued on a first come first served basis; program may end if funds are depleted.



Rebate Amount:

- ◆ A \$100 rebate (less \$5 voucher) will be issued for replacing a toilet flushing 2.5 gallons per flush (gpf) or more.
- ◆ A \$50 (less \$5 voucher) for the replacement of a toilet flushing 1.6 to 2.5 gpf.
- ◆ A \$50 rebate will be given in new construction for installing a qualified 1.28 gpf toilet in lieu of a 1.6 gpf model.

Checklist:

- Select and purchase a WaterSense toilet.** Qualifying models often are identified with a WaterSense label at the store. Verify by reviewing the list of qualifying toilets on the EPA website: <http://www.epa.gov/watersense> Toilet model number(s) must match the numbers on the WaterSense list exactly. No mixing and matching of tanks and bowls from the list is allowed as each model has been tested in specific combinations for performance and efficiency.
- Install WaterSense toilet.** Installation is the responsibility of the applicant. Keep the portion of the new toilet's box / packaging with make and model number. **DO NOT dispose of old toilets until inspection by MWC.**
- Attach sales receipt and submit your completed rebate application form.** Applications will be processed in the order received. If your application is sent by mail or delivered to our office, MWC will contact you to confirm eligibility and set up an inspection. You may also contact us before submitting your application.
- Scheduling an inspection.** Applicants' signature on this form authorizes MWC to perform an onsite inspection. *If toilet is being installed by a plumber, call us in advance* and we will attempt to coordinate the timing of our inspection with your plumber. This will enable us to provide them the voucher necessary for recycling the old toilet at the transfer station. Call us at (541) 774-2435 to schedule an inspection.
- Recycle old toilet at Rogue Disposal Transfer Station.** Upon inspection by MWC, a voucher will be issued for recycling. If you hire a plumber, be sure to inform them that the old toilet must be recycled and work out any details ahead of time. Rogue Disposal will validate the voucher and direct you to the designated recycle container. **Recycling the old toilet is required for receipt of rebate.** All metal and plastic parts must be removed from the old toilet before being recycled.
